

Please be advised that T.W.S. Chimney Sweeps and Services will be at the Lower Kootenay Band from Sept 12th to Sept 14th starting at 9:00am. Those of you that burn wood during the winter months will be receiving a chimney sweep.

T.W.S requests to please leave your basement door unlocked on the day of your scheduled sweep, this will allow them to enter home with limited contact to you, and your family. If you have any questions regarding T.W.S going into your home at this time, please call the LKB Housing Coordinator to discuss further.

Please test your fire alarms, replace your furnace filter, and make sure you have a fire extinguisher in the kitchen. Notify the Housing Coordinator if you have any concerns regarding fire safety in your home, or if you burn wood regularly and your chimney was not swept on September 12th -14th, 2022.

Campfires to be permitted in the Southeast

August 31, 2022

Castlegar – Effective at 12:00 noon PDT on Friday, September 2, 2022, campfires will be allowed in the Southeast Fire Centre. The current prohibition against any open fire larger than a campfire (i.e., larger than 0.5 metres wide by 0.5 metres high) remains in effect throughout the Southeast Fire Centre.

The following equipment and activities remain prohibited throughout the Southeast Fire Centre:

- Category 2 and Category 3 open fires, as defined in the Wildfire Regulation
- the use of sky lanterns
- the use of fireworks
- the use of air curtain burners
- the use of burn barrels and burn cages
- the use of binary exploding targets

Anyone lighting a campfire in an area where campfires are allowed must maintain a fireguard by removing flammable debris from around the campfire area, attend the fire at all times, and must have a hand tool or at least eight litres of water available nearby to properly extinguish the campfire. Before lighting a campfire, the public is urged to check with their local regional district or municipality for local open burning bylaws.
