- Vicky Thomas of KNC Lands and Resources Sector provides background in respect to the Economic and Community Development Agreement (ECDA) and the Strategic Engagement Agreement (SEA). The ECDA should have been renewed by October 2021. There are financial impacts if an extension is not signed. The SEA is up for renewal in March 2022.
- KNC staff is requesting guidance and direction from all of the Ktunaxa communities. In order to allow further discussion with the communities, they are recommending to extend the agreements for 2 years.
- Vicky Thomas met with Heather Suttie and Curtis Wullum to discuss the possible impacts of not renewing the agreements.
