In response to this event, Cherie Luke sent a letter to the Board of Trustees informing them of their failure and received a letter back from the Board Chair which seemed to minimize the event and fail to come up with a plan to make sure this sort of thing does not happen again The Council discussed the potential of have a 2-day session with SD8 staff and trustees to discuss issues of concern and educate the educators
