	• Curtis Wullum states that he did not "approve" a site at the old reservoir site on Crawford Hill. He did not think that it was aa ideal space as it is rather busy location and not conducive to a mediative/contemplative experience. Curtis Wullum did however refer Ann Deatherage back to Band Council.
	 Jason Louie does not see how a Healing Forest in the Town of Creston benefits LKB? How is this reconciliation? Truth is essential.

	LUANNE ARMSTRONG BOOK – DYKING ON THE FLATS
	 Luanne Armstrong has been commissioned to write a book for 100th
	Anniversary of Creston concerning the diking of the Creston Valley Flats.
	 Ron Toyota suggested that Luanne Armstrong contact Curtis Wullum to
	get information about how diking has impacted the Band.
	• Jason Louie states that the book must reflect the truth about how we were put forcefully on LKB lands. How settlers were handed lands that were initially ours. They stole this land for YN people – write that in your book.
	 Josie Fullarton agrees and it should also be told how the diking affected our culture. How that changed the life of our ancestors.
	 Robin Louie states how important it is to say the truth – once written becomes history.
	• Chad Luke states that Luanne Armstrong has contacted him personally and states that she wants to tell the truth about the valley.
	 Jason Louie – What guarantee do we have that they will publish the truth even if Luanne writes it? If LKB participates and the truth is not told does our participation imply approval?
	 Heather Suttie will contact Luanne Armstrong and state that if LKB is to participate, "the YN story of the valley" must be approved by LKB prior to it being published.
